II. A major in History leading to the Bachelor of Science (non-teaching) degree with a concentration in a history-related career area consists of 63 s. h. **Note:** A 2.0 average must be maintained in the major. (All courses in sections II & III.)

History Major: (36 semester hours above core curriculum history requirement)

36 s.h. distributed as follows. A minimum of 15 s. h. from one of the areas listed below, and a minimum of 9 s. h. from each of the two remaining areas; and 3 s. h. in History 4100 (Senior Seminar). No more than 15 s. h. from the 2000 level may be included to fulfill these requirements. One of these courses must be the second Writing Designator (marked "W" in the catalog listing) required in the major.
