**A 2.0 major GPA is required for graduation. Major GPA calculation will include all courses taken in the major department. Minimum of 18 semester hours of courses taken to fulfill major requirements must be courses offered by Appalachian.**

40 semester hours above freshman level with at least 9 semester hours at the 2000 level and at least 28 semester hours must be at 3000 level or above (**ENG/CI 3590 (W, S) is required**). The average of the grades in English courses must be at least a 2.00 G.P.A. ALL COURSE SELECTIONS SUBJECT TO DEPARTMENTAL GUIDELINES FOR TEACHER EDUCATION. Please secure checklist from English Department, Room 200, Sanford Hall.

**NOTE:** Students should not take both halves of the American literature sequence or the British literature sequence at the sophomore (2000) level.
